- First batch of 18 students graduated successfully the Yoga Alliance teacher training course (200 hours)
- Weekly yoga classes for over 100 students since 2019
- Offered many free yoga workshops

### Aum Ashram

Aum Ashram is a project of Aum Education Society of Texas, a non-profit organization

#### Goal

To promote the knowledge of Vedic culture and ancient Indian science of Yoga for all age groups while also bringing value based education to preschool and school age children

### Ashram Highlights

- Ashram design is inspired by Mahatma Gandhi Ashram in Sabarmati, Gujarat
- Surrounded by hundreds of trees, careful planning will bring best elements of nature and spirituality to the ashram
- > This is the first stage of ashram construction with additional expansion to follow in future
- Classrooms are designed with state of the art technology
- Groundbreaking: 25th October 2020 on Vijayadashami. Open doors: Summer 2021
- First of many such schools coming to United States, Aum Ashram San Antonio, will bring the practice of spirituality, yoga and Vedic education for the next generation under one roof

#### Aum Ashram Future Activities


- Community garden

## Aum Ashram Plan






